



## Classification of Living Things Activity for Kids

### Candy Classification DIY




 Duration: **30 min**

 Difficulty: **Easy**






 Cost: **\$0 to \$20**

Classify candy using a dichotomous key!

### Material List

-  Different types of candy
-  Piece of paper
-  Pen

### Instructions

-  Study the different types of candy and put them into 2 broad groups, based on their shared traits.
-  Once you have the 2 groups sorted, split each group into more specific groups.
-  Continue this until you are left with just one type of candy.
-  Make a dichotomous key based on the traits you sorted by.
-  The key should be a flow chart, with a simple question at each step.

### How It Works

Living things are classified by scientists using shared traits to help them understand how they are related. We can use this same process to classify candy! Each question in the key leads you to another question until it finally leads to one type of candy. This activity can be done with leaves and many other things around you. Sorting by shared traits is an important skill to practice since it is used in many scientific investigations.
