Material List

- 1** Storage bin
- 1** Gallon of water per person per day
- 3** Days worth of canned food or other non-perishable foods
- 1** Set of flashlights and batteries
- 1** First aid kit
- 1** Pack of candles and matches
- 1** Envelope with copies of important family documents
- 1** Tool kit
- 1** Can opener
- 1** Roll of duct tape
- 1** Package of toilet paper & tall plastic bags

Instructions

- 1** Pack all of the items in the storage bin.
- 2** Keep it somewhere safe and accessible in the event of a natural disaster.
- 3** Check your kit once a year to make sure it is ready to go.
