Material List

- 1 Storage bin
- 1 Gallon of water per person per day
- 3 Days worth of canned food or other non-perishable foods
- 1 Set of flashlights and batteries
- 1 First aid kit
- 1 Pack of candles and matches
- 1 Envelope with copies of important family documents
- 1 Tool kit
- 1 Can opener
- 1 Roll of duct tape
- 1 Package of toilet paper & tall plastic bags

Instructions

- 1 Pack all of the items in the storage bin.
- 2 Keep it somewhere safe and accessible in the event of a natural disaster.
- 3 Check your kit once a year to make sure it is ready to go.

How It Works

Experts recommend making an emergency kit with at least 3 days worth of essential supplies for you and your family to prepare for natural disasters. Make sure to recheck your kits once a year, to make sure you're ready to go. Your kit can have more things than described in the video. Remember, we can't stop natural disasters from happening, but we can take steps (like making an emergency kit) to reduce their impact.
